On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit transformed the frightened Apostles into fervent preachers. Can we, too, be open to the transforming power of the Holy Spirit? Through the power of the Holy Spirit we can share in Christ's mission; we become emboldened to share our faith through evangelization.

## **Ordinary Time**

In his apostolic letter approving the Roman calendar, Pope Paul IV noted some important facts about the liturgical year: Over many centuries, Catholics had become accustomed to so many special religious devotions that the mysteries of redemption lost their proper place. This was due to the large number of vigils, holydays and octaves, and to the growing dominance of various seasons over the Church year;

St. Pius X and Blessed Pope John XXIII restored Sunday to its former dignity, so that everyone should once more consider it as the Church's original feast day. The popes restated the traditional teaching of the Church: The celebration of the liturgical year has a special sacramental power and force which nourishes and strengthens life of Christians. The Church year is not merely a recalling of the historical events by which Christ won our salvation. The reason for the restoration of the liturgical year is to help believers through their faith, hope and love to share more fully in the entire mystery of Christ as it is unfolding throughout the year.

## **World Day of Prayer for the Church in China – May 24<sup>th</sup>**

In May 2007, Pope Benedict XVI asked that May 24<sup>th</sup> be observed as a Day of Prayer of the Church in China. He chose this day since it is the traditional feast of Our Lady of Help of Christians, who is venerated at the Shrine of Sheshan in Shanghai.

## **A new language**

On Pentecost day the apostles spoke a new language.

What was this new language?

It was the language of peace rather than of war;  
the language of cooperation rather than of competition;  
the language of forgiveness rather than of vengeance;  
the language of hope rather than of despair;  
the language of tolerance rather than bigotry;  
the language of friendship rather than of hostility;  
the language of unity rather than of division;  
the language of love rather than of hate.

Through the gift of the Spirit,  
people of different languages learned to profess one faith,  
to the praise and glory of God.

That is the real miracle of Pentecost,  
and it is a miracle which, thankfully, still happens.
