### **Focus of the Sunday Readings**

The Holy Spirit will strengthen us with courage in times of trouble.

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Stephen was faithful to his Lord even as he lay dying. Hatred did not consume him; rather forgiveness was on his lips and in his heart. May we pray often to Saint Stephen for his intercession as we struggle to be forgiving when faced with dissension and conflict.

The first reading from Acts recalls the martyrdom of Stephen. As he dies, he sees Jesus in heaven with God. Stephen asks forgiveness for his murderers. The second reading gives us hope that the day of the Lord's return is near. In the Gospel, Jesus prays that all people may be united with him and with God the father.
