REFLECTION – Jesus told the crowd his flesh was the bread God sent from heaven. He also said that anyone who ate of his flesh and drank his blood would live forever.

After they heard what Jesus said, many of his followers complained, "The words of Jesus are hard to accept. Who can stand to listen to what he says?"

Jesus already knew they were grumbling. "So, what I said bothers you? 62 What would you say if you saw the Son of Man return to heaven where he came from?"

It is God's Spirit that can give you true life. You can't get that life by yourselves. My words bring you God's Spirit and his life.

But, there are some of you that don't trust me." (From the start, Jesus had known some followers didn't trust him. Jesus also had known the follower who would hand him over to the leaders in Jerusalem.) 65 "This is why I have told you no one can be my follower," Jesus continued, "unless he receives an invitation directly from my Father."

From then on, many of his followers left Jesus. 67 So, Jesus asked the Twelve, "Don't you want to leave, too?"

"Lord, who else would we want to follow?" Simon Peter answered. "You speak the words that lead to eternal life. We have trusted you all this time. And we have come to know that you are God's Holy One."

Relationships come go in life. But real friends remain faithful through thick and thin. John's gospel presented the problem of fidelity in a very straight forward way. Some will leave. Some will stay.
