MARK 12:28-34



REFLECTION This was a story about an agreement — between Jesus, Mark's lead protagonist, and a scribe, a group member of Jesus' leading archenemies. And, this moment of harmony should make any contemporary reader pause. Matthew's ancient parallel refused to portray Mark's story without adding in that this scribe arrived to "test" Jesus. Many interpreters read Mark's account in the same manner. The scribe simply wasn't really interested in arriving at common ground. But Mark's account depicted this Jerusalemite as a sincere scribe. Jesus and this scribe agreed!

Stories like this one, rare as they are within the Christian canon, must drive us to become more willing to open up to the other, including the faithful people within our own religious tradition and those without. With Jesus, at the least, may we be able to admit that these people of faith are also "not far from the kingdom." Can we go beyond Jesus and discover in our fellow companions of faith people who are "in" the "kingdom," that is, they, too, have religious commitments that allow them to share in God's love for the world. For many of us in the contemporary world, love for our neighbor coincides with a respect of our neighbor's belief system or lack thereof. By this respect for our neighbor, we carry out the mission of human
