Saints For the Month Of July

July 22 Mary Magdalene – was a woman who, according to the four canonical gospels, traveled with Jesus as one of his followers and was a witness to his crucifixion and resurrection. She is mentioned by name twelve times in the canonical gospels, more than most of the apostles and more than any other woman in the gospels, other than Jesus' family. Mary's Magdalene may mean that she came from the town of Magdala, a fishing town on the western shore of the Sea of Galilee in Roman Judea.

July 25 James, Apostle – is describes as one of the first disciples to join Jesus. The Synoptic Gospels state that James and John were with their father by the seashore when Jesus called them to follow him. James was one of only three apostles to bear witness to his transfiguration.

July 26 Joachim and Anne Parents of Mary the Church remembers St. Joachim and St Anne , the parents of the Virgin Mary. Despite the importance of their role as the maternal grandparents of Jesus, we do not know much about them. We know that Joachim was a shepherd from Jerusalem, married to Anne. While Joachim was at work in the fields as usual, an angel appeared to announce the birth of a child, and Anna also had the same vision. So they called their little girl Mary, which means "loved by God" and they moved to Nazareth, where they educated Mary, teaching her the law of the Lord. We do not know when Joachim and Anne died.

July 29 – Martha – Martha welcomed Jesus and served him, and they developed a special bond of friendship. Jesus asked Martha to believe that he was the resurrection and that he had power to give eternal life to all who believe in him. Without really understanding this mystery Martha trusted Jesus totally and said, "I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who was to come into this world". That day Jesus raised her brother Lazarus from the dead, showing that he has power over life and death to give eternal life.
