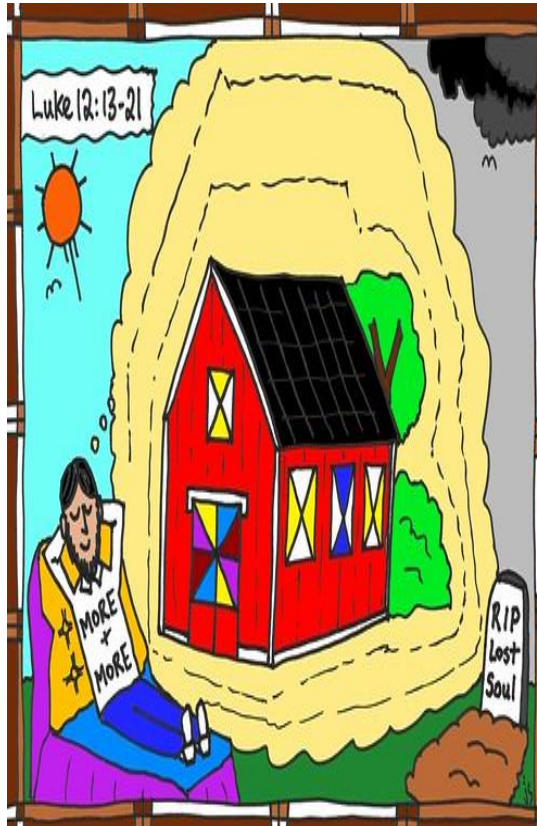

Many who hear this parable, especially in a North American context, may wonder: Why is the rich farmer called a fool?

The rich farmer is a fool not because he is wealthy or because he saves for the future, but because he appears to live only for himself, and because he believes that he can secure his life with his abundant possessions.

When the rich man talks in this parable, he talks only to himself, and the only person he refers to is himself: “What should *I* do, for *I* have no place to store my crops?” “*I* will do this: *I* will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there *I* will store all my grain and my goods. And *I* will say to my soul, ‘Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry’” (12:17-19).

KNOW OUR SAINTS

St. Jean-Marie Vianney – August 4

St. John Vianney, was a French Catholic Priest who is venerated as a saint and as a patron saint of parish priests. He is internationally known for his priestly and pastoral work in his parish in Ars France. In 1818 Vianney was appointed parish priest of the parish of Ars a town of 230 inhabitants. Vianney came to be known internationally, and people from distant places began travelling to consult him as early as 1827. By 1855, the number of pilgrims had reached 20,000 a year. During the last ten years of his life, he spent 16 to 18 hours a day in the confessional. Even the bishop forbade him to attend the annual retreats of the diocesan clergy because of the souls awaiting him yonder.

Vianney had a great devotion to Saint Philomena. Vianney regarded her as his guardian and erected a chapel and shrine in honor of the saint. During May 1843, Vianney fell so ill he thought that his life was coming to its end. Vianney attributed his cure to her intercession.

On August 4 1859, Vianney died at the age of 73, the bishop presided over his funeral with 300 priests and more than 6,000 people in attendance.
